## LACE LEAF & SPECIALTY MAPLE

### Lace Leaf

Name	Height	Summer Color	Fall Color	Comments
Atropurpureum	3-6'	Red	Red tones	Very hardy lace leaf type
Autumn Fire	5-6'	Green red	Red	Red edged new growth
Baldsmith	3-6'	Variegated	Yellow orange	Orange new growth, ages to green w/pink
Crimson Queen	3-6'	Red	Red tones	Dense, broad mounding habit
Ever Red	3-5'	Red	Scarlet	Red spring leaves age to maroon
Garnet	3-6'	Red	Red tones	More upright lace leaf variety
Green Cascade	3-6'	Green	Yellow, orange, red	Most unusual form of Acer japonicum; pendulous branching
Jeddeloh Orange	3-6'	Green	Yellow orange	Orange tones in spring
Julian	3-6'	Red	Orange red	Large leaves for a lace leaf
Orangeola	3-6'	Green	Reddish burgundy	Orange color on spring growth
Red Dragon	3-6'	Red	Red tones	Purple maroon color
Red Filigree Lace	3-6'	Red	Bright yellow	Very finely-cut green leaves
Tamukeyama	3-6'	Red	Red orange	Good in full sun, very vigorous grower
Variegata	3-6'	Variegated	Yellow tones	Striking variegated foliage, protect from sun
Viridis	3-6'	Green	Golden yellow	Standard green foliage variety
Waterfall	3-6'	Green	Gold tone w/crimson	Nice pendulous habit

### Specialty

Name	Height	Summer Color	Fall Color	Comments
Acer pseudoplatanus 'Puget Pink'	10-12'	Variegated	Gold	Pink new growth, ages green
Circinatum 'Pacific Fire'	10-15'	Green	Gold, red, orange	Bark is bright red in winter!
Circinatum 'Sunglow'	4-5'	Peach/green	Plum red	New leaves peach to orange, aging to green
Pseudoplatanus 'Crimson Sentry'	15-20'	Purple	Maroon	Narrow 10-15' wide
Pseudoplatanus 'Eskimo Sunset'	15-20'	Variegated	Yellow, gold, orange	Green, pink and white foliage; needs some protection from hot sun
Truncatum 'Pacific Sunset'	15-20'	Variegated	Yellow/red blend	Green foliage with splashes and flecks of white
